Responsibility –	The Tennis Program Expert will be responsible for establishing tennis development structures (TDS) across the country, which shall include planning, implementing, monitoring and evaluating these structures once put in place.

These tennis development structures (TDS) should be the catalyst for the following objectives to be achieved for Thai tennis and its players:

- a) Continued Elite Performance Player Development
- b) Development of LTAT's four Regional Training Centers, with focus on Elite Performance Training Center in LTAT Stadium, Nonthaburi

Role Requirements – (LTAT Academies)

- Creation of programs / tennis structures blue prints in brief & detail.
- Assigning times lines required in implementing these programs.
- Managing the high performance tennis program at the LTAT Stadium in conjunction with Thai coaches assigned for the program.
- Evaluating and working with individual / small groups of high performance players, while creating individual player pathways for them to continually better their competing performances.
- Documenting technical progressions and requirements for players to achieve maximum growth potential while competing.
- Visiting and working with the players of LTAT Regional Tennis Academies with the focus of gradually turning the academies into centers of excellence in the region.
- Documenting various requirements that need to be fulfilled by the Regional Training Academies in order for them to deliver high quality training programs.
- Making suggestions to the LTAT on solutions required for each center to perform better and keep improving.
- Organize regular planning & discussion sessions with the LTAT coaches, while working both at the regional and central academies, with an aim to helping local coaches strengthen their competence and teaching abilities.

(High Performance Players)

- Work on technical and tactical improvement of Elite players, maximizing their potential.
- Based on initial observation and track records of these player, communicating and discussing objectives, while establishing reasonably aggressive goals for players in a time bound manner.



- Structuring individual / combined macro and micro planning for the elite players while drawing out tournaments / training schedules etc.
 - Monitor performances and redraw strategies based upon evaluations, every quarter.
 - Motivate and educate the players in every way possible, in order to increase competencies.
- Coach's Personality –
- Self-motivated and should have proved his competencies in previous job profiles.
 - Positive and confident of working in an environment which would require him to take initiatives, develop long term strategies.
 - A pro-active approach at understanding the current scenario of tennis development of the organization, and drawing out strategies (short & long term)
- Qualifications –
- Bachelor's Degree or equivalent
 - ITF Level 3 Certification or its equivalent
- Work Schedule –
- The profile would require a 6 days a week work ethic and working hours would need to commensurate with the objectives which are required to be achieved. A high degree of adaptability & understanding would be most essentially expected of the incumbent*.

- Males between 35 – 40 years of age
 - Experience of 7 – 10 years in coaching high performance players required
 - Worked in a similar capacity / role managing high performance academies and players.
 - A strong understanding of progression in internationally accepted players' pathway is essential.
 - Previously high ATP ranked would be strongly preferred
 - Strong inclination to engage and encourage the elite group of players by way of competitive training.
 - Comprehensive reporting and analytical abilities, in order to furnish information of his working in quarterly / yearly reports.
